**\*Necessary Information/ Conditions about Cash Awards:**

- To be eligible for Cash Award, it is mandatory (100 students from each class i.e. moving to Class VI, VI & VIII) to join our Classroom Programme Latest by 31st December, 2020.
- Students joining Two Year Classroom programme / Three Year Classroom programme / Three Year Classroom programme / Five Year Classroom programme for Class VI, VII & VIII total Cash Awards will be disbursed in equal installments.
- To be eligible for Cash Awards, a student needs to maintain a minimum of 85% attendance in classes and Common Practice Test.

**NOTE:** In case a student is found to have used unfair means during the N-SAT test, he/she shall be disqualified from the N-SAT Scholarship Scheme & Cash Awards.
